IFB Gaming is a digital inclusion organisation that connects organisations to people to create more inclusive pathways into digital participation and AI literacy. We achieve this through outreach, digital inclusion solutions such as our toolkits, strategic partnerships, and reporting. Our flagship programme, Empowering Futures, includes our Winter Data Care campaign and is powered by the National Digital Inclusion Network and IFB Gaming.

We are strengthening our board and particularly welcome applicants who bring lived experience of digital exclusion or who are underrepresented on boards.
